5. Hear all sides of an argument presented, including your own.
6. Enjoy innovative, inspiring services and programs and share your ideas.
7. Help build the Judaism of Tomorrow, today.
8. Be challenged by a dynamic, rational approach that comforts the afflicted and afflicts the comfortable.
9. Share a love for Israel, which includes debate and critique, just as we do in America.
10. Be a member of an inclusive community which those of all creeds and backgrounds may call home.
